I-PAD APPS & SCHOOL SUPPLIES LIST 2016–2017

Parents: this i-PAD Apps and school supplies list will provide you with an excellent start for the new year. With these materials in hand, your child will be ready for the first day of school. Additional materials may be required as the year progresses.

STANDARD FOR ALL GRADES

Loose leaf paper, pencil pouch with red and black erasable pens, number 2 pencils, small pencil sharpener, a ruler, package of colored pencils, one folder



INDIVIDUAL DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- **Sixth Grade Supply List:** Please refer to the list posted under Middle School Documents on our web site.
- **Algebra, Math 1, Math 2 and Math 3:** Calculator and protractor, graph paper, dry erase pens and eraser, mechanical pencils and eraser
- **Horsemanship:** boots with a heel, an ASTM approved helmet & long pants.
- **Physical Education Department:**
 - P.E. Uniform: Purchase through the Athletic Dept. P.E. Department-issued shirt, shorts, sweat shirt and sweat pants.
 - Athletic socks: keep (1) clean pair in P.E. locker at all times.
 - Cross-trainer (running) athletic shoes with laces: no vans, skate shoes, sandals, slip on shoes, Uggs, slippers, boots, etc. will be allowed.
 - Personal Hygiene Travel Kit: keep in P.E. locker at all times.
**P.E. Dept. will provide combination locks for all P.E. students.*

I-iPad Requirements:

- Stylus for iPad (optional)
- Earbuds or headphones
- iPad Apps: (to be purchased by the student; see the Apple store for current cost)

For presentations, we are requiring students to purchase an App such as **Keynote**, and **iMovie**.
For word processing we are requiring students to purchase an App such as **Pages**.

Both Apps are currently available on the iTunes App Store

For note taking App students have some freedom in what they choose to use, however, whatever choice is made, the following capabilities are required:

1. Ability to import a pdf.
2. Be able to ink on a pdf, and enter typed text.
3. Ability to export the edited pdf.

A suggested App for note taking is **Notability**, but there are many others.
The Help Desk in the ARC and teachers will be familiar with the Notability App.
