

PURPOSE: To encourage high scholastic attainment.

MEMBERSHIP:

- * Semester: Granted to those achieving membership qualifications during each semester.
- * Life: Seal bearer status granted to those achieving four semester memberships, one that **MUST** be in the senior year.
- * 100%: Granted to those with continuous membership of six semesters during their sophomore through senior years.

ALL VALEDICTORIANS AND SALUTATORIANS MUST BE SEAL BEARERS!!!

QUALIFICATIONS FOR SEMESTER MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION:

A student carrying 4 or 5 subjects (not counting P.E. and repeated subjects) must earn a minimum of 10 CSF points, 7 of which must be from List I and II (two subjects and 4 points **MUST** be from List I) and the remaining 3 points may be from List III.

SENIORS ONLY may substitute three List II courses for their List I requirements. All courses beyond five will not be used to compute CSF points. Any D's or F's will immediately debar the student for that semester.

CSF POINTS ARE COMPUTED AS FOLLOWS:

A = 3 points

B = 1 point

C = 0 points

A = 4 points Honors or AP class

B = 2 points Honors or AP class
