Tuition and Fees 2015-2016

New Student Application Fee: *This (non-refundable) fee is charged for each new student upon application for admission. The fee covers screening and processing of the application.*

New Student Enrollment Fee: *This (non-refundable) fee is charged for each student every year at MVCS and must be returned with the enrollment contract to secure placement.*

2015-2016 Day Tuition includes:

Additional (*optional) Expenses:

- School Supplies: notebooks, calculator, etc. (varies)
- Field trips*: vary depending on class and travel involved
- MS March Term trips-6th grade (Science Camp), 7th grade (Oceanography Camp), 8th grade (Washington DC)*: \$300 - \$2200 (fundraising opportunities are available)
- Dual Enrollment (HS only)*
- Academic Assistance Program*
- Athletic Fees*: HS: \$50-\$100/sport - MS: \$25-\$40/sport
- PE clothes: shirt & shorts - \$30
- Horsemanship for PE*: \$1100-\$1500/semester
- Bus Transportation*: \$95 - \$210/month
- Parking Placards (licensed drivers)*: \$30
- Cafe: \$3/snack & \$7/meal (depending on selection)*
- ASB Sticker*: \$15
