Automobile Agreement and Release

Automobile Rules and Regulations

Students (12th graders) and parents must realize that the possession and use of cars for Monte Vista boarding students is a privilege and not a right. This privilege is reserved for seniors. Student's car and driving privileges may be reviewed and/or revoked at any time for academic and/or disciplinary reasons.

- 1.** Boarding students must submit a completed and signed Automobile Agreement and Release Form, signed Automobile Rules and Regulations Form, and a copy of the Primary Automobile Liability Insurance policy to the Office of Residential Life.
- 2.** Each student who has an automobile on campus must have Primary Automobile Liability Insurance coverage as stated on the Automobile Agreement and Release Form of at least \$250,000 - \$500,000 -\$250,000 and a Personal Excess Liability Umbrella Insurance Policy with a limit of at least \$1,000,000, in addition, Monte Vista Christian School must be named as an "additional insured" **or** parents must defend, indemnify, and hold forever harmless Monte Vista Christian School, etc.
- 3.** All boarding students must register their cars with Student Services immediately upon arrival on campus.
- 4.** Boarding students are allowed cars on campus for personal use only, and may not transport other students.
- 5.** Car and driving privileges will be reviewed and may be revoked in the event of a traffic accident, traffic violation, personal misconduct, major school rule violation, or an accumulation of minor school rules.
- 6.** Students should expect to have their car and driving privileges revoked for at least 6 weeks if they use their car while violating a major school rule.
- 7.** Car keys will be kept in the dorm office.
- 8.** Students may not lend their car to other students. Students who violate this rule should expect to lose their car and driving privileges for at least 6 weeks.
- 9.** Students must always sign out their cars on the sign-out sheet, posted in the dormitory, before leaving campus with their car. .
- 10.** The speed limit on campus is 15 MPH. Students who drive above this or drive recklessly should expect to receive a disciplinary response for a first offense and lose their car and driving privileges for at least 6 weeks for a second offense. Their car will be impounded during this period of time.
- 11.** Monte Vista Christian School cannot assume any responsibility for vandalism, damage, or theft of any student's car or theft of items in the car.
- 12.** Student must notify the Office of Residential Life whenever they change cars or bring different cars to campus.
- 13.** Monte Vista Christian School reserves the right to search or inspect any students' car anytime the car is on the Monte Vista Christian School campus, with just and reasonable cause.
