- Guests must bring a current school ID card for identification purposes
- Students and guests are to abide by the school's code of conduct while attending MVC-sponsored events. Dress code violations, public display of affection and/or inappropriate behavior may warrant disciplinary action, parent notification and/or removal from the event.
- All students attending a dance must arrive within the first hour and stay until the final hour. Students may not leave prior to the last hour.

The Special Event Guest Pass Application must be complete before submittal will be accepted. The MVC Administration must receive the application by 4pm two days prior to the event at the latest.

Monte Vista Christian Expectations for School Dances

Dance Attendees: All Monte Vista Christian High School students in good academic and behavioral standings may attend school-sponsored dances such as Homecoming, Winter Ball and Prom.

Prom is for Juniors and Seniors and invited MVC underclassmen. Other guests may include alumni students under the age of 20 years accompanied by a current MVC student. Students may also invite one non-MVC guest under the age of 20 years to Winter Ball and Prom only. All guests and alumni are required to complete a guest application form that must be turned in at least three days in advance of the event in order to be preapproved and attend the dance.

Guest Application Form: The MVC guest application form may be picked up in the Student Services office and must be signed by all noted parties. Both a parent and principal/dean of students signatures are required if the guest is currently in high school. If the student is under 20 years and is not in high school, the form must still be signed by a parent/guardian. The form details host and guest behavior expectations and dress code. The guest application form must be complete and received at least three days in advance of the dance in order to be considered for approval.

Dancing Styles: No freaking, twerking, grinding, or any other sexually provocative dances are allowed at any time during the dance. Dancing must not include excessive body contact or any inappropriate touching or grabbing.

- **Consequence:** If a student and/or guest is found to be breaking dance conduct, they will be escorted off the dance floor and only allowed back at the discretion of a chaperone. If the behavior still continues, parents will be contacted and the student and/or guest will be required to leave the dance.

Dance Dress Code for Boys: Button up shirts, pants, and shoes are to be worn at all times during the dance. Undershirts or tank tops are not to be visible or worn as outer garments. All other MVC dress code standards apply.

Dance Dress Code for Girls: Clothing must be modest and fit properly covering the back, cleavage and midriff. Sheer clothing is not to be worn if it exposes areas noted. Dresses and skirts may be shorter than regular school-day dress code standards, however may not be shorter than fingertip length. All other MVC dress code standards apply.

- **Consequence:** If a student and/or guest is found out of dress code, they will be provided school-issued clothing and/or make parent contact to remedy the situation.
